

## Student register Oodi becomes the new student and study information system of the UEF

The University of Eastern Finland will start using a joint student and study information system, Oodi, on all its campuses at the turn of 2009–2010. Students will have access to the online interface of Oodi, i.e. WebOodi. WebOodi is already in use at the University of Joensuu. The Wossikka services at the University of Kuopio will be normally available to students and teachers **until 29 December 2009**. Student and studies-related data from the Otto/Wossikka student information system currently used at the University of Kuopio will be transferred to Oodi in early January 2010. Oodi will be taken into use after the data transfer, **on 11 January 2010**.

## Student register will be unavailable from 30 December 2009 to 10 January 2010

Please note that **during the period 30 December 2009–10 January 2010, the student register of the University of Eastern Finland will be unavailable**. Both of the online student information systems – WebOodi and Wossikka – will be unavailable to students during that period of time, and this concerns all campuses of the UEF: Joensuu, Kuopio and Savonlinna.

In other words, if you can make your registrations etc. already in the autumn semester, it's wise to do so before January 2010:

- Registration for the spring semester must be done in Wossikka/WebOodi by 29 December 2009. However, it is also possible to make the registration in person at Student Services (previously the Student Affairs Office) until 15 January 2010.
- When possible, you should sign up for your spring semester courses/groups and exams in Wossikka/WebOodi by 29 December 2009 at the latest, or in WebOodi in January 2010.
- Feedback on the autumn semester courses should be given in Wossikka/WebOodi by 29 December 2009 at the latest, and feedback on the spring semester courses will be given in WebOodi.

Students are recommended to make a list of the following things pertaining to their uncompleted courses and courses beginning in January:

- list of course registrations;
- course contact information and timetables;
- course materials, especially for the exams in week 2!

- In Finnish 13.1.2010 at 14-17 MC2, 15.1.2010 at 8-11 MC9 and 19.1.2010 at 13-15 MC9.
